Instructions for using Magic Ink Tattoo Ink:

Do not attempt to activate or deactivate Magic Ink tattoos until fully healed

Preparation:

- Ensure the tattooing area is clean and sanitized, sterilize all tattoo equipment including needles, tubes, and grips.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (gloves, mask, etc.)

Setting up:

- Shake the Magic Ink bottle well before use to ensure proper mixing of pigments. Pour Magic Ink into a clean ink cap.

Tattooing Process:

Failure to follow these directions may result in an unsuccessful Magic Ink tattoo.

Do not tattoo with Magic Ink under bright lights.

- Dip the tattoo needle into the Magic Ink, ensuring the needle is fully saturated.
- Begin tattooing on the prepared skin, following the desired design.
- Monitor ink flow to ensure consistent color and saturation.
- Re-dip the needle into the magic ink as needed during the tattooing process

Storage and Handling:

- Store Magic Ink in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight.
- Do not dilute Magic Ink with any other substances unless explicitly recommended by the manufacturer.

Post-tattoo care:

- Once the tattoo is completed, clean the area thoroughly with sterile saline solution or mild soap and water.
- Apply a thin layer of recommended aftercare ointment or lotion as per standard tattooing practices.

Safety precautions:

- Only use Magic Ink on intact healthy skin surfaces.
- Avoid contact with eyes.
- Keep Magic Ink out of the reach of children and pets.
- In case of any adverse reactions or concerns, seek medical advice immediately.
- Never use UV lights during the tattoo process.
- Do not use UV lights on tattoos until the tattoo is completely healed.

Professional use only:

- Magic Ink is intended for use by professional tattoo artists only.
- Ensure compliance with local regulations and guidelines for tattooing practices.

Dispose of used materials properly:

- Magic Ink bottles are single use only.
- Dispose of any leftover Magic Ink properly according to local regulations for hazardous waste.

Artist Suggestion:

- Magic Ink has been engineered to compensate for various artistic styles. While artists will find their best technique to apply Magic Ink to skin effectively, it is recommended to apply Magic Ink to skin with maximum particle load and minimal damage to skin. Magic Ink, when deactivated, will reveal the damage done to skin. Therefore, it is vital that artists do not overwork skin, thus minimizing scar tissue for the damage left by the tattoo procedure. Should an artist overwork the skin, although Magic Ink will become nearly invisible when deactivated, the damage to skin will not.
- We strongly recommend testing Magic Ink on yourself or friends using a variety of needles and techniques before using Magic Ink on clients.

Ingredients:

- Water (aqua), polymethyl (methacrylate), photochromatic compound, poly (vinyl alcohol), ethyl alcohol, glycerine

Lights IFU

To activate your Magic Ink tattoo use your uv light. Hold the light directly on the tattoo for 3-5 seconds.

to deactivate your Magic Ink tattoo use your turn on your white light. hold the light directly on the tattoo for 5-10 seconds.

Caution:

- Keep away from children.
- Do not shine in eyes.
- Do not activate or deactivate your Magic Ink tattoo more than 5 times a day
- Do not hold the light on skin for longer than 5 seconds per activation.
- Discontinue usage if irritation occurs and contact a board-certified dermatologist.

Replace AAA batteries often
